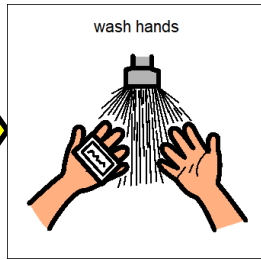
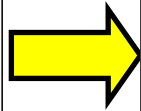
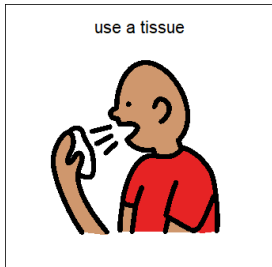
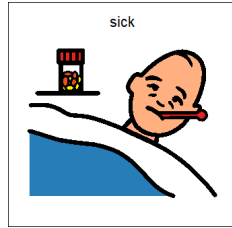
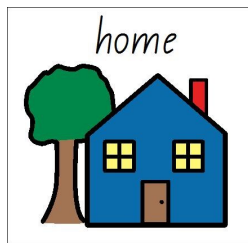
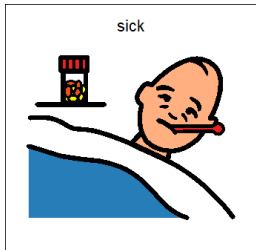


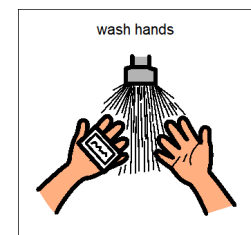
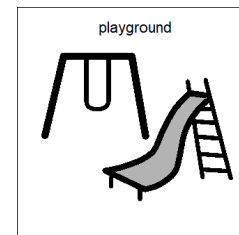
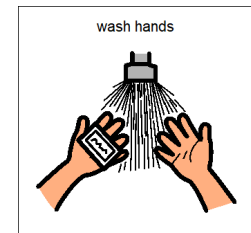
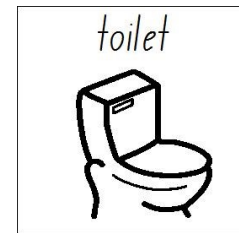
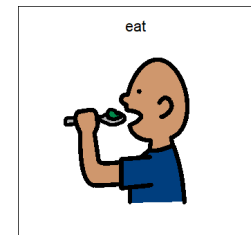
Sometimes I get sick and need to cough or sneeze. I will cough or sneeze into a tissue or my elbow, then wash my hands.

At home and at school I will keep my hands clean. I will wash my hands before I eat, after I use the toilet and after I play.

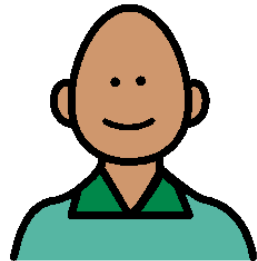
